Home Inspection Prep Checklist

Prepare for your home inspection!

Here is a list of tasks to help you prepare for a home inspection, and ensure a complete inspection.

For Sellers:

- **1.** Clean and declutter key areas: Ensure easy access to the attic, crawl space, water heater, electrical panels, and HVAC systems.
- 2. Check for minor fixes: Replace burned-out lightbulbs, fix leaky faucets, and ensure doors and windows open/close properly.
- **3.** Test safety features: Confirm smoke and carbon monoxide detectors are working and replace batteries if needed.
- 4. Label utility shut-offs: Clearly mark the location of water, gas, and electrical shut-offs.
- **5.** Secure pets: Ensure pets are secured or taken off-site during the inspection.

For Buyers:

- **1.** Be present if possible: Attend the inspection to ask questions and better understand the property's condition.
- 2. Come prepared: Bring a notebook, pen, and a list of questions or concerns about the property.
- 3. Know what's covered: Inspections focus on the home's current condition, not cosmetic issues.
- **4.** Expect a detailed report: Same-day delivery means you'll get the results quickly, so you can move forward with confidence.
